Proposal for a regulation**Article 30 a (new)***Text proposed by the Commission**Amendment**Article 30 a**Shipments from an outermost region*

1. By way of derogation from Article 5(5), Article 8(3), (4), (5) and (6) and Article 9(1), (2), (6) and (7), for shipments of waste between an outermost region referred to in Article 349 of the TFEU and its Member State requiring transit through another Member State, a tacit decision of consent to transit shall be deemed to have been issued by the authority of transit, unless that authority of transit objects within three days of receipt of written consent from the competent authority of dispatch and destination.

2. Such tacit consent shall be valid for the period mentioned in the written consent of the competent authority of dispatch and destination.
