**Hello from Naples.** Last week, FEAD's President Claudia Mensi joined the Green Med Symposium, hosted by Italian member Assoambiente, to discuss the crucial role of associations like FEAD in promoting transparency and **combatting greenwashing**. Meanwhile, European lawmakers in Brussels were busy reviewing **draft reports** on two critical pieces of legislation - the **packaging** waste regulation and the classification, labelling and packaging of **chemical substances**. As the discussions unfolded, it became increasingly clear that MEPs were sharply divided over the issue of whether to prioritise recycling or reuse in the fight against packaging waste.

# EU INSTITUTIONS MONITORING <



**Waste Shipment Regulation (WSR):** EU Environment Commissioner calls for 'decisive multilateral action' on climate change, biodiversity loss, and pollution, notes that COPs decisions would have 'profound impact' on global management of chemicals and waste.

**Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR):** EU Parliament's ENVI committee debates packaging regulation draft report, MEPs divided over reuse and recycling.

- ITRE rapporteur proposes changes to EU Packaging Regulation, including a delay in recyclability requirements for innovative packaging and a 90% collection target by 2030
- IMCO committee to hold debate on draft opinions on the packaging regulation on 23 May
- Conference of Committee Chairs recommends that Environment Committee retains responsibility for packaging regulation
- Circular economy companies urge French Minister to support reuse in European packaging regulation

**Renewable Energy Directive (RED) - Delegated Acts:** Commission acknowledges falling behind on presenting RED delegated acts, seeks extension of power to adopt them.

**Net-Zero Emissions Regulation:** Key dates set for legislative process of Net-Zero Emissions Regulation by MEPs, rapporteur to submit draft report on 26 May.

**Climate Package:** EU to exceed 2030 emissions target, says Timmermans at COP28 preparatory meeting.

**Single-Use Plastic Beverage Bottles:** EU Commission proposes method to calculate recycled content in plastic bottles, but chemical recycling not included yet.

**Ecodesign for Sustainable Products Regulation (ESPR):** MEPs set to vote on Ecodesign for Sustainable Products Regulation on 5 June 2023.

Classification, labelling and packaging (CLP) of chemicals regulation: Council experts

discuss revisions to CLP chemical regulation, with compromise proposals including the sale of refills, online sales, and the classification of multi-component substances.

• ENVI committee considers draft report proposing group classification for substances

**PFAS:** EU removes derogation allowing manufacture and sale of PFOA, a persistent organic pollutant, effective from August 2023.

**Microplastics:** Six countries across Europe warn Commission of lack of legislation to meet microplastics reduction target.

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) - Targeted proposal to amend Article 12, paragraphs 1, 3 and 4, Article 13(1) and Article 15(2) of the WEEE Directive as a follow-up to the judgement of the CJEU (C-181/20) to clarify when the financing obligation for producers apply: Council experts to examine a steering note from the Swedish Presidency on the targeted proposal on 12 May 2023

**Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS) and Carbon Capture and Utilisation (CCU):** EU to publish communication on CCS and CCU role in decarbonisation, with sector targets and investment estimates.

**Carbon Removal Certification (CRC):** Rapporteur proposes extension of Carbon Removal Certification framework to third countries, potentially including UK.

**Urban Waste Water Directive revision – ENVI Committee considered draft Report:** MEPs discuss concerns over extension of wastewater treatment requirements in Urban Waste Water Directive revision proposal.

We welcome the Parliament's view to ensure long-lasting, reusable, repairable, recyclable, and hazard-free textile products in the EU market and highlight the **need for a robust framework to create and scale up a strong recycling industry for textile waste**, which is an essential component of a sustainable and circular textiles strategy.
