Last week the EU publishing game has been on fire! We saw the Waste Shipment Regulation but also the Environmental Crime Directive and the Industrial Emissions Portal Regulation gracing the pages of the Official Journal of the EU.



Waste Shipment Regulation published: On 30 April, the text of the new Waste Shipment Regulation was [published](#) in the Official Journal. This means that it will so enter into force in 20 days and apply from 21 May 2026.

G7 Communiqué: On 30 April, the G7 released a meeting [communiqué](#) on their commitments.

Renewable Hydrogen production projects: On 30 April, the European Commission [announced](#) that seven renewable hydrogen production projects have been

selected in the first call for tenders from the European Hydrogen Bank.

Feedstock for the production of biofuels and biogas: Member States

have [confirmed](#) that they will not oppose the expansion of the list of authorised raw materials for the production of biofuels and biogas according to a document by the Council.

Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee 4 (ICN4): The fourth meeting of the ICN closed on the night of 29 April. During the meeting, a [revised draft text of the international legally binding instrument on plastic pollution, including in the marine environment](#) was validated.

Environmental Crime Directive publication: On 30 April, the revised environmental crime directive was [published](#) in the Official Journal of the EU.

Social Climate Fund public consultation: On 30 April, the European Commission launched the [public consultation](#) on the Social Climate Fund that will be open until 28 May.

Sustainability reporting standards: On 29 April, the Council [approved](#) the directive to delay reporting obligations for certain sectors and third country companies.

Industrial Emissions Portal (IEP): On 2 May, the Regulation establishing a portal on industrial emissions was [published](#) in the Official Journal of the EU.

EEA report on climate-resilience: On 29 April, the European Environment Agency published a [report](#) on the role of cities for climate-resilience.

2024 European Elections - European Parliament: On 27 April, the Spanish Socialists Workers' Party [announced](#) that Teresa Ribera will be their lead candidate for the elections.

2024 European Elections - European Commission: The Spitzenkandidaten of the various political groups debated on the Green Deal during the 29 April [Maastricht debate](#) in preparation of the European elections.

FEAD News: On 3 May, FEAD, in cooperation with CEWEP, Municipal Waste Europe and SGI Europe, sent out a [joint statement](#) stating that 'all heat recovered from the thermal treatment of waste (Waste-to-Energy – WtE) should be considered as waste heat in the

framework of the Renewable Energy Directive (RED) and the Energy Efficiency Directive (EED).'

Last week, FEAD participated as a correspondent to the two-day 19th IED Article 13 Forum Meeting organised by the European Commission. On 2 May, FEAD also participated to the Waste to Resource public hearing at the European Economic and Social Committee.
