Critical Raw Material Regulation (CRM): During a 20 September **conference**, Dimitri Lorenzani, member of the cabinet of Maros Sefcovic, new Commissioner in charge of the Green Deal, stated that one of the major obstacles of CRM is social acceptance.

Waste Shipment Regulation revision (WSR): A second round of Trilogues took place on 21 September.

The Council released a 4-column document that presents the key elements of negotiations after the first Trilogue from 31 May.

Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR): The revised compromise on PPWR was discussed on 29 September, in the Council at the Working Party on the Environment.

Agreement concerning the International carrying of Dangerous Goods by Road

(ADR): Two proposals, presented by FEAD to the RID/ADR/ADN <u>Joint Meeting</u> last week

in Geneva, have been approved. FEAD has proposed to integrate rules about packaging in the ADR and RID that are specifically applicable to waste since it is not the case now.

PFAS: The ECHA consultation on the restriction of PFAS closed on 25 September.

Renewable Energy Directive (RED): COREPER I approved, during a meeting on 27 September, the European Parliament's first reading position on the revision of RED.

Urban Wastewater Treatment Directive: The PPE group published an <u>amendment</u> for the plenary vote on the revision on the urban wastewater treatment directive.

Classification, Labelling and Packaging of substances and mixtures (CLP): On 4

October, the European Parliament will adopt its position on CLP during the plenary session.

Chemical substances: Contexte <u>reports</u> EUROSTATS' <u>numbers</u> on the sale of chemical substances by the EU which show that production is continually increasing.

Microplastics: On 25 September, the European Commission <u>adopted</u> its text restricting microplastics intentionally added to products.

European Commission: On 27 September, the European Commission published its <u>calendar</u> for possible items for the College for the next semester.

PFAS in the waste sector

The European Chemical Agency (ECHA) presented a report on the presence of PFAS in waste streams in April. This report states that the chemical should be massively restricted, even though it is already largely regulated. This restriction could have a major impact on the waste sector. In order to give Member States a clearer view of the situation, FEAD is performing, in collaboration with the University of Padova, a systematic critical review of the scientific literature to collect PFAS concentration ranges in waste items categorized within the relevant four waste categories: plastic waste; paper and cardboard waste; textile and leather waste; and metal waste. The conference on Wednesday the 8, will provide the results of the first part of this study.

The event will start with two 20-minute presentations: one of the report by ECHA and the second one the results of the Critical review. A panel discussion will follow, featuring high-level experts in different area of this field. A Q&A with the public will close the event.
